## WHO

All students in their final year of a CACB accredited architectural degree program graduating fall 2011 or spring 2012.

Students at all accredited Canadian schools are automatically eligible; those from other accredited North American schools may also apply, subject to presenting career plans.

## WHAT

\$10,000 Bursary (Forgivable Loan) for up to three eligible applicants, payable upon successful completion of the applicant's degree and proof of a bona fide offer of qualified employment in Saskatchewan.

The forgivable loan would be repaid after graduation by internship with an SAA firm or member at a Saskatchewan location. The repayment would be forgiveness at the rate of one-third for each completed year of internship in Saskatchewan.

## WHY

Intern architects in Saskatchewan are welcomed by the greater design community, actively impacting the cultural exchange of the cities and communities where they practice.

Senior architects support the interns and provide opportunities of significant responsibility. Opportunities abound as a result of Saskatchewan's strong economy and burgeoning enthusiasm for design.
